

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The above sanction is subject to fulfillment of following conditions:-

- 1. The grant of recognition is not extendable and does not in any way imply any obligation to recognize/affiliate beyond class VIII.
- 2. The School shall abide by the provisions Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Act-2009 and the Odisha Right to Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2010.
- 3. The School shall admit in class I, to extent of 25% of the strength of that class, Children belonging to weaker section and disadvantaged group in the neighborhood and provide free and compulsory Elementary Education till its completion.
- 4. For the Children referred to in paragraph 3, the School shall be reimbursed as per section 12(2) of the Act. To receive such Reimbursement School shall provide a separate Bank Account.
- 5. The Society/School shall not collect any captioned fee and subject the child or his or her parents or guardians to any screening procedure.
- 6. The School shall not deny admission to any child for lack of age proof. If such admission is sought subsequent to the extended/ provided/ prescribed for admission. On the ground of religion, cast or race, place of birth or any them.
- The School shall ensure:
 - No child admitted shall be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of Elementary Education in a school.
 - No child shall be subject to physical punishment or mental harassment. (ii)
 - No child is required to pass any board examination till the completion of (iii) Elementary Education.
 - Every child completing Elementary Education shall be awarded a certificate as laid (iv) down under Rule-22.
 - Inclusion of Students with disabilities/special needs as per provision of Act. (v)
 - The teacher are recruited with minimum qualifications as laid under Section12 (1) (vi) of the Act.
 - The teacher performs its duties Specified under Section24 (1) of the Act. (vii)
 - The teacher shall not engage themselves for private teaching activities. (viii)

- 8. The School shall follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum laid down by appropriate authority.
- The School enrolls students Proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the Section 19 of the Act.
- 10. The School shall maintain the standards and norms of the School as specified in section 19 of the Act. The facilities reported at the time of last inspection are as given under:
 - Area of School Campus
 - Total Built-up area
 - Area of play ground
 - · No. of Class rooms
 - Room of Headmaster-cum-office-cum-storeroom
 - · Separate toilet for Boys and Girls

- 11. No unrecognized classes shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the same name of the School
- The School buildings or other structures or grounds are used only for the purposes of Education and skill development.
- The School is run by a society registered under the societies Registration Act, 1860 (21 of 1860), or a public trust constituted under any law for the time being in force.
- The School is not run for profit to any individual, group or association of individuals or many other persons.
- 15. The account should be audited and certified by a Chartered Account and proper account statement should be prepared as per rules. A copy each of the statement of Accounts should be sent to the DEO every year.
- 16. The recognition code Number may please be noted and quoted for any correspondence with this
- 17. The School furnishes such reports and information as may be required by the Director Elementary Education/District Education Officer/ Block Education Offices as the case may be from time to time and complies with such instructions of the state Government/Local Authority as may be issued to secure the continued fulfillment of the condition of recognition or the removal of deficiencies in working of the schools.
- 18. Renewal of Registration of Society if any be ensured.
