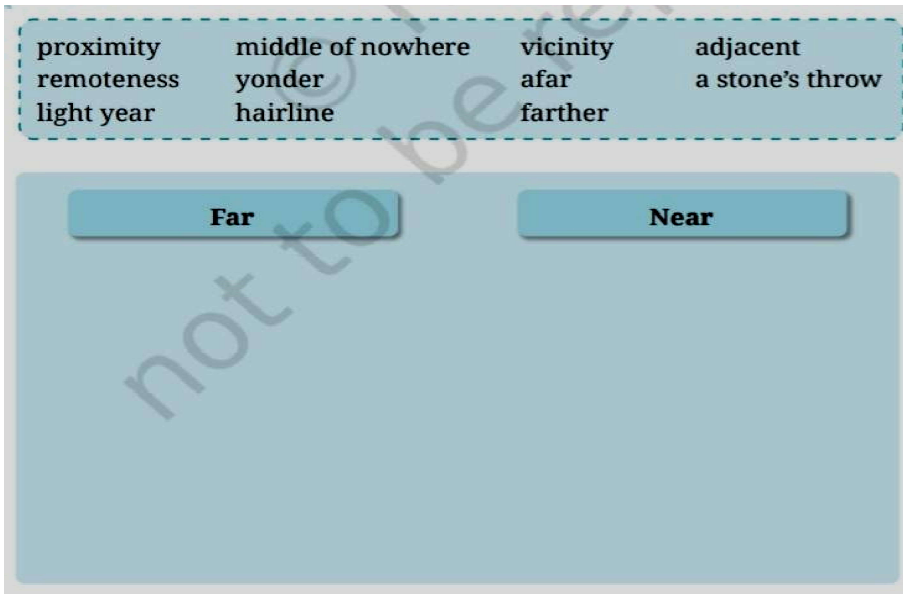

Case Study 1: The Protective Himalayas

The Himalayan range, known as the "abode of snow," stretches for about 2,500 kilometers across northern India. It consists of three main ranges: the Himadri (Greater Himalayas), Himachal (Lower Himalayas), and Shivalik Hills (Outer Himalayas). These mountains act as a natural, towering barrier that protects India from cold, dry winds from Central Asia and influences the climate by intercepting monsoon winds, causing heavy rainfall.
